



pin the tail on the crocodile instructions

STEP 1 Print these two pages out and take them to a copy centre. Ask them to enlarge the pages to A2 poster size (they need to be at least this big so the kids can pin the tail on the crocodile).

STEP 2 Cut out the tails on this page (there is an extra one in case you need it).

STEP 3 Attach some double sided tape or blutack on the back of the tail, so that the tail sticks when it is placed.

STEP 4 Hang the poster up somewhere where there is enough space to move around, making sure it is at a height that is good for the kids to reach.

STEP 5 Make a blindfold with a piece of fabric or scarf.

STEP 6 Make sure an adult is nearby to guide each child to the wall for safety. Spin the child and send them on their way to pin the tail on the crocodile! Give each child a turn to play.



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
